FAQS:

- Does my athlete have to be a Storm player in order to participate?
 - No, clinics and games are open to all athletes, not just Storm athletes.
- Can I stay and watch my athlete?
 - Per COVID guidelines at Sports on 66...
 - No spectators are allowed for clinic sessions.
 - For 2nd and 3rd grade athletes: Sports on 66 has made an exception and one parent per athlete will be allowed to watch the clinic session.
 - One spectator per athlete may be in the gym to watch games
