Dear Parents/Guardians,

With the spring weather quickly approaching, we wanted to clarify some of the aspects of our dress code policy. Students will be expected to dress and groom his/herself for the business of school in a manner that does not distract other students or teachers and promotes safety and the educational process. We will adhere to the following guidelines:

- Sandals must have back straps (no flip flops).
- Shoes must have solid soles (no rollers/Heelies)
- Messages or pictures on clothing must be respectful. Clothing may not contain profanity or make references to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sexual behavior, or firearms.
- Shirts must cover the midriff, any cleavage, and backs. Camisole tops can only be worn under shirts. Tank tops with thick straps can be worn.
- Underwear (including bra & camisole straps) must not be visible.
- Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than mid-thigh.
- Hats, bandanas, hoods and other head-wear must only be worn outside.

If you have any specific clothing questions, please give the school a call. If a student's attire is judged to be in violation of the above guidelines, he/she will be sent to the office and the procedures written in the student agenda will be followed. Students will be reminded of the policy and a letter will be sent home.
