In preparation for this day students are invited to find and bring in as many or as few of the following items to help a variety of causes.

- Using a gallon bag (which will be used as a blessing bag for the homeless) students can put the following items:
 - Canned goods or nonperishable items for the Colchester Food Bank
 - Pet food for the Connecticut Humane Society
 - Loose change or small monetary sum for a cause which may include the Haitian Health Foundation, Red Cross, Salvation Army, and/or the Homeless Hospitality Center
 - Clothing items to donate to child in our school or other worthy cause
 - Items for blessing bags to give to the homeless (granola bars, bottles of water or juice boxes, fruit containers, canned goods with a flip-top lid, forks/spoons)
 - Yarn or twine for a kindness project
 - Small packets of seeds to make and take a recyclable seedball
 - Rolls of duct tape to use to create an upcycled item
