

# William J. Johnston Middle School Students Present at CECA Tech Expo

Seven students from WJJMS in Colchester were selected to present their work with state legislators at the State Capitol for the 2019 CECA Tech Expo on May 1 at the Legislative Office Building. The CECA annually grants up to three awards that recognize excellence in the integration of technology into K-12 classroom learning.
