

Colchester Public Schools Registration FAQ's:

Do I need to complete a new registration application for each one of my children attending CPS?

Yes – An online application must be completed for each student who is entering CPS along with proof of residency and health/immunization records. (please refer to Registration checklist) We suggest that you complete the registration process for each student one at a time.

Do I have to answer all the questions on listed on the Ecollect registration forms?

Questions marked with a red asterisk (*) are required on the PowerSchool online registration form.

What if I have questions about the online registration process?

What documentation do I need for a student who is transferring from a different school?

Complete a School Record Release Form must to request records from a previous school.

Why must students attending out-of-town magnet schools register with Colchester Public Schools?

Students that attend out-of-town magnet schools are required to be registered and meet residency requirements so that as a school district, we assure that we are paying Magnet School tuition for Colchester Residents only.

What if my family is homeless?

Whenever feasible, CPS will minimize the effects of mobility on homeless students by maintaining a stable educational environment. If you are temporarily “doubled up” with a friend or relative due to economic hardship, loss of housing, or a similar reason, your student may qualify as homeless under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Act. Please contact our homeless liaison for more information.

What if I currently reside with a friend or relative?

If you voluntarily share the housing with a friend or relative that permanently resides in Colchester, a notarized Residency Affidavit is required.
